Dellwood Picnic

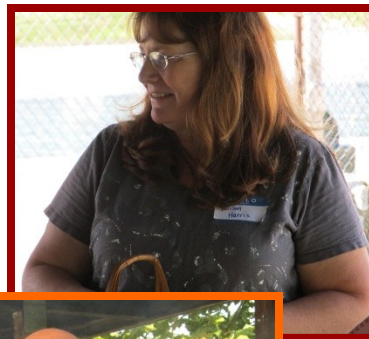

Notes from Board Meeting

The DHA board met on October 11, 2014. Items discussed:

- **No Soliciting Sign** - It has been suggested that we place a "No Soliciting" sign at the entrance to Dellwood. All roads in Dellwood are state roads and the state controls a right-of-way along the roads. The right-of-way extends 30 feet from the center of the road and any sign would be prohibited in this area. These restrictions would place the sign very far off the road and onto someone's property. It doesn't seem that a sign is a practical solution at this time. The post office does allow "No Soliciting" signs on individual mailboxes. - **Picnic** - Marty Harris organized the annual picnic. The picnic was at the large pavilion in Patton Park. Please contact a board member if you have any suggestions for the 2015 picnic.
